

## Foundation Academy Dress Code Policy per the Student Handbook

### On a daily basis students will wear:

- Solid Red, White, or Navy blue solid color shirts with collars
- Solid Red, White, or Navy blue solid crew neck sweatshirts
- Solid Long sleeved shirts may be worn underneath uniform shirt if they are red, white, or, navy blue
- Navy, Khaki (tan), or Black pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers
- Any Foundation Academy spirit gear at any time
- Closed toed shoes, closed-heel shoes
- Tennis shoes for gym class

### On a daily basis and on dress down days, students will NOT wear:

- Sagging pants
- Jeans or pants with rips, holes, tears, frays, or patches (Distressed)
- Hats, hoods, caps, bonnets, bandanas, du-rags, or any other head gear
- Any type of gloves or hand coverings
- Hooded sweatshirts (unless it is campus wear)
- Shirts with inappropriate words, pictures, profanity, images, logos, or showing skin
- Open toed shoes such as flip flops/sandals and open back shoes
- Tops with spaghetti straps, crop tops, midriff tops, sheer tops, or tops showing skin
- Leggings UNLESS they are worn under a dress or long, loose top (covering the bottom)
- Tight fitting pants and shorts
- Jackets tied around the waist

### Reminders

- Kindergarten & Grade 1 parents: Send a change of clothes in case of accidents.
- Borrowed clothing must be **washed & returned**.
- Enrolling means you **agree to follow** the dress code—refusal may lead to suspension or expulsion.

### Dress Code Violation Steps

1. Teacher calls home (documented)
2. Letter sent home—parent must sign & return
3. Administration meets with student; possible consequences
4. Student spends day in **ALC** until in compliance
